Covid 19 Risk Reduction – Site Rules

Issue date 12/9/20

Note 1: Everyone entering the site shall comply with these rules, which are required to reduce the risk of Covid 19.

In addition to these rules, specific risk assessments that include eg: sailing, power boat use, training, windsurfing, camping, use of club equipment and Government guidelines shall be followed.

Note 2: Everyone includes all instructors, coaches, visitors and groups/clubs eg: fishing club, gig club, Plumpton, air cadets, sea cadets, sailability, RYA school, BWS, Scouts.

Site Rules

1. Bring your own face mask.
2. On first arrival of the day, entry is only through the pedestrian gate entrance (to control signing in).
3. Sign in your name and contact number for track and trace purposes (book by entrance).
4. Sanitize your hands on arrival and leaving (sanitizer station is by entrance)
5. Keep 2m apart or 1M+ with face covering.
6. Changing and showers rooms are closed and must not be used. (difficult to control cleaning and distancing).
7. Toilets remain open. Spray before/after use (spray provided).
8. Galley is open for drinks only, no more than two at any time, spray before/after use (spray provided).
9. Hand sanitizer stations are located at: pedestrian gate, outside galley, outside changing rooms, disabled toilet, hire shed, engine shed.
- 10 Equipment sanitizer sprays are located near the equipment, spray before/after use.
